### CHATEAU VALENTONS CANTELOUP AOC Bordeaux Supérieur Moelleux

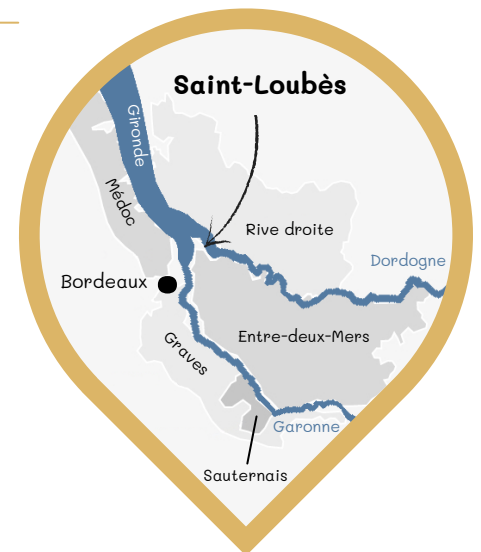
<b>Area</b>	About 3 hectares.
<b>Age of the vineyard</b>	About 20 years.
<b>Planting Density</b>	4200 vine-plants/hectare.
<b>Grape varieties</b>	100% Sauvignon Gris
<b>Nature of the soil</b>	Clay and silt soil with a Red Gravels' subsoil.



<b>Viticulture</b>	Ploughing on 2/3 of the area. Thinning out of the grapes if necessary. Harvest with sorting table. Sustained agriculture.
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<b>Vinification</b>	Over maturation. Low temperature fermentation. Specific aromatic yeasts.
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<b>Aging</b>	Aging on thin lees (3 months)
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<b>Tasting notes</b>	Slightly straw color, moderate sweetness with notes of flowers (lime, verbena) and spices (cinnamon, vanilla).
<b>Food/wine pairing</b>	With foie gras, desserts, blue cheeses or for the aperitif.
<b>Cellaring</b>	10 years.
